Oct.14-15 Horseback Riding and Hiking near Pine Creek

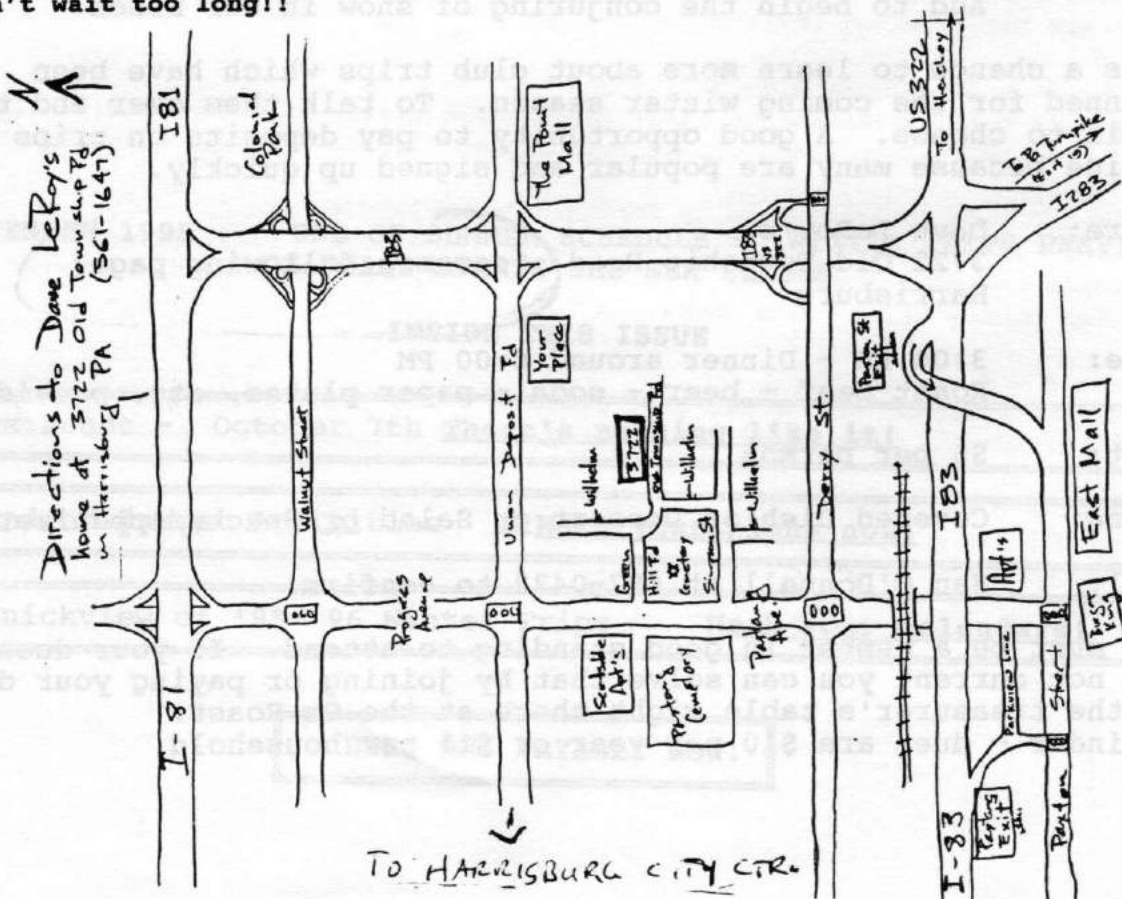
