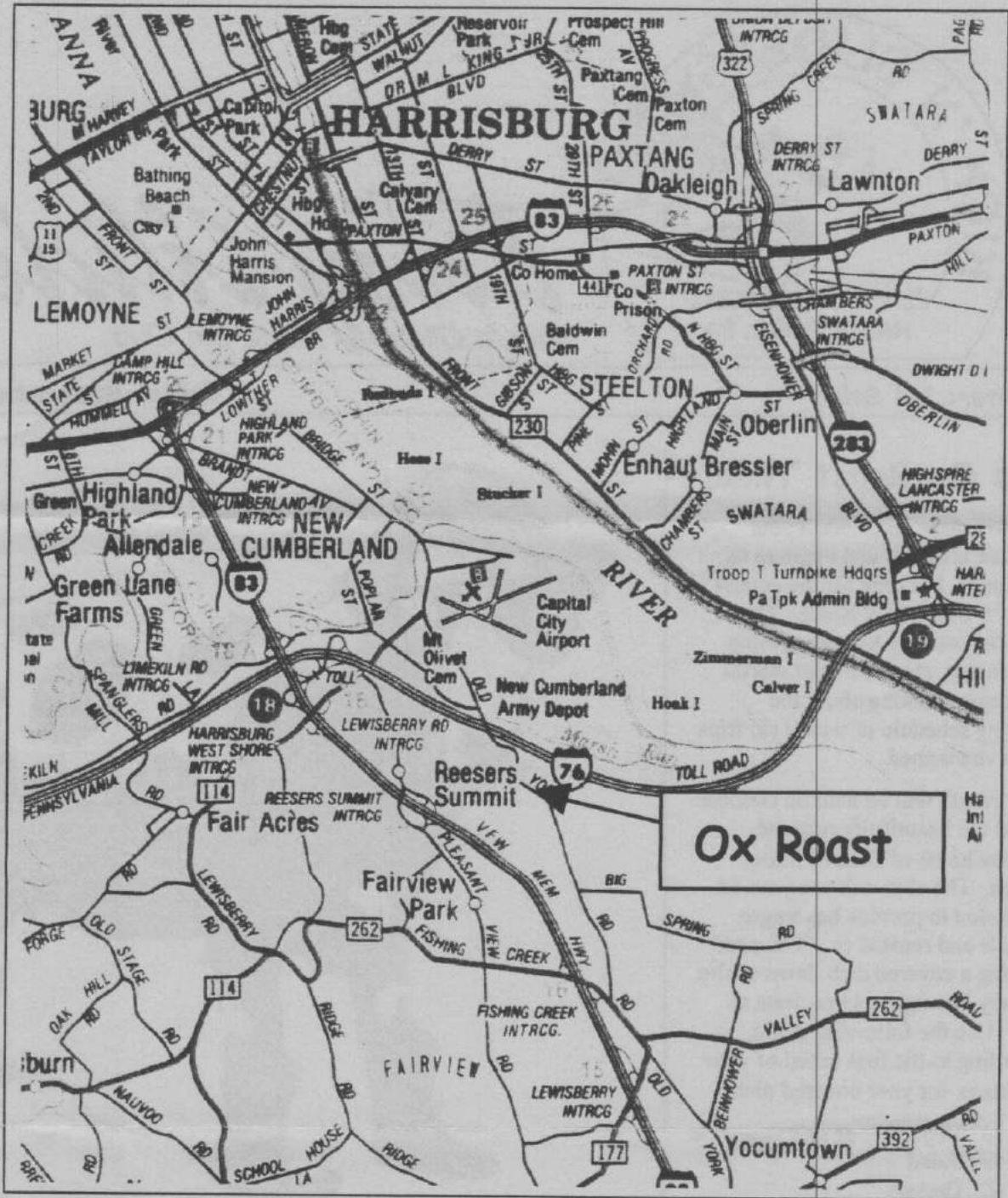

- If you come to a farm, you have gone too far!



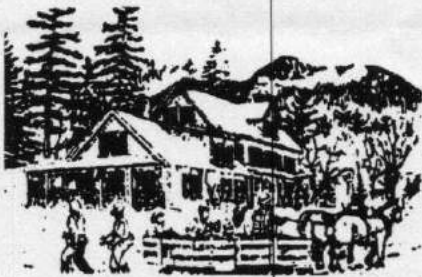
