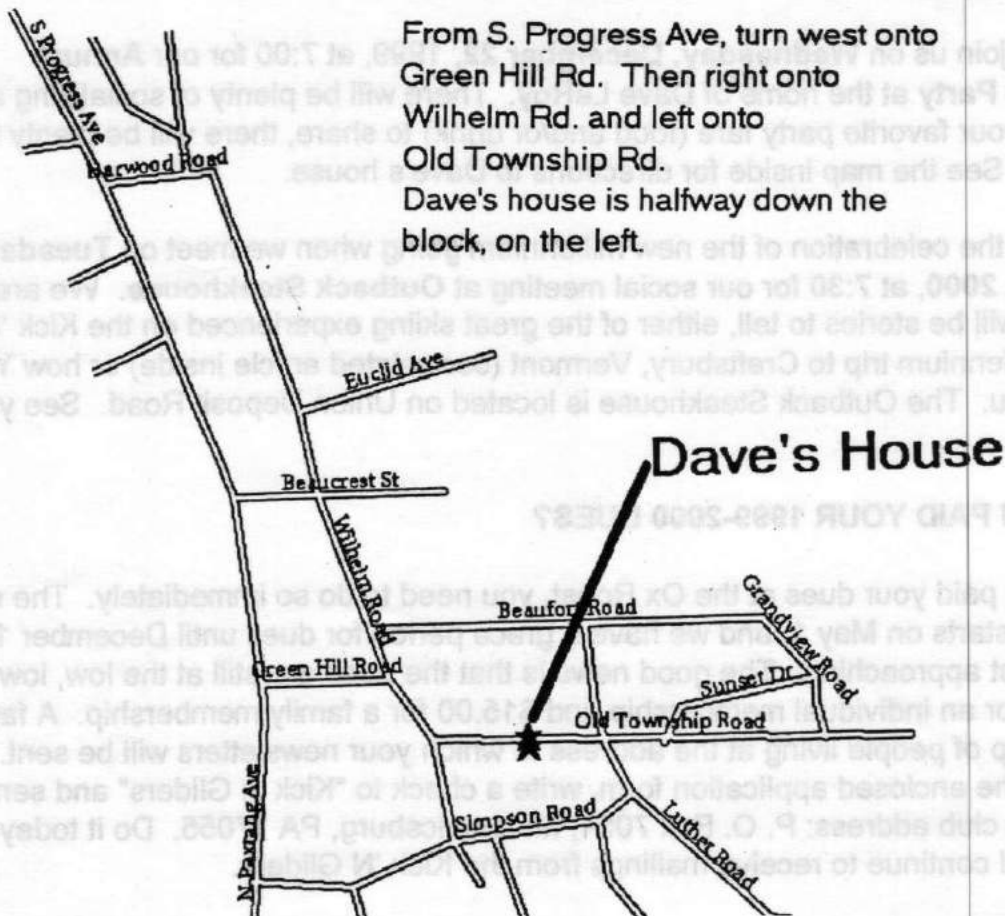
MILLENNIUM TRIP UPDATE

Dave LeRoy reports that a total of 20 people have signed up for the Millennium trip to Craftsbury, Vermont. The size of this trip has been reduced to 25, so only 5 spots are still available. If you are still deciding whether to go on the last trip of this millennium (and the first trip of the next millennium) you should send \$100 to the club address (Box 7054, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055) as soon as you make up your mind. The trip will involve five days and four nights at a charming New England nordic center where we ski out-the-door and eat homemade meals three times a day.

The bad news is that we will not have a bus this year. But the good news is that this reduces the cost of the trip to \$275 per person. Those who have signed up for the trip are talking about car pooling using rented 15-passenger vans. This will be a likely option.

We remind you that the trip begins on December 29, 1999 (arrive as early in the day as you like) and ends on January 2, 2000. We will probably spend one day at the Trapp Family Lodge (of "Sound of Music" fame) and are planning a gala New Year's Eve Party with Champagne and a bonfire. 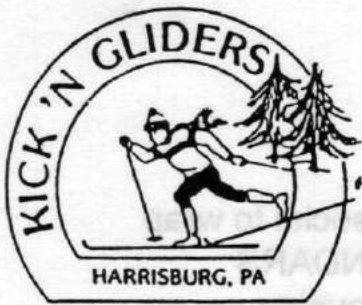


End of Year Social Event
