Guide to Cross Country Skiing in Pennsylvania



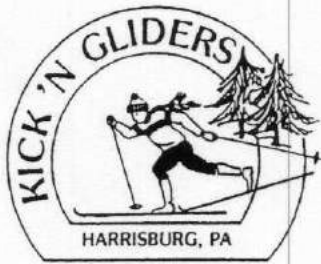
