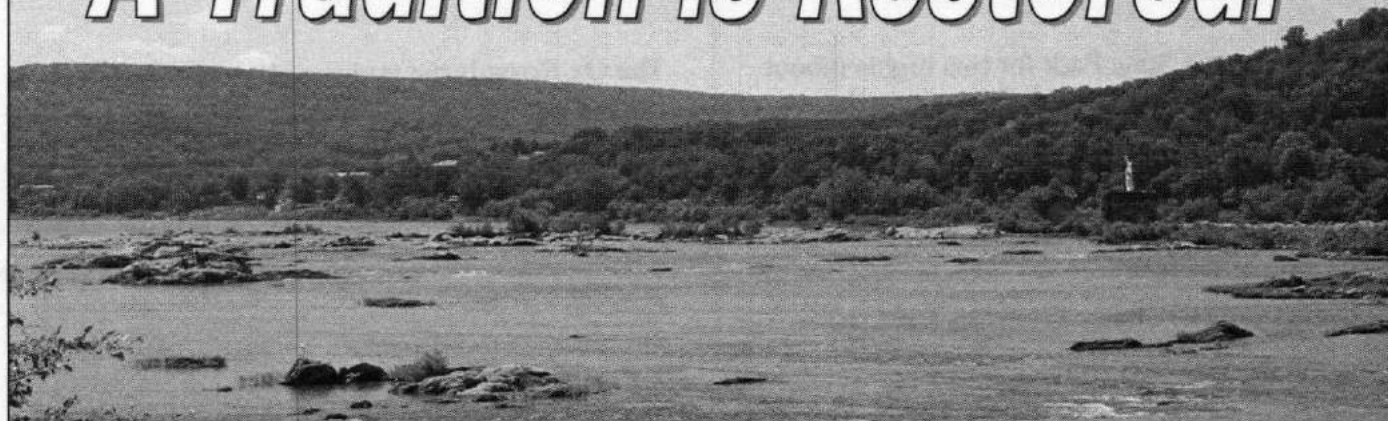

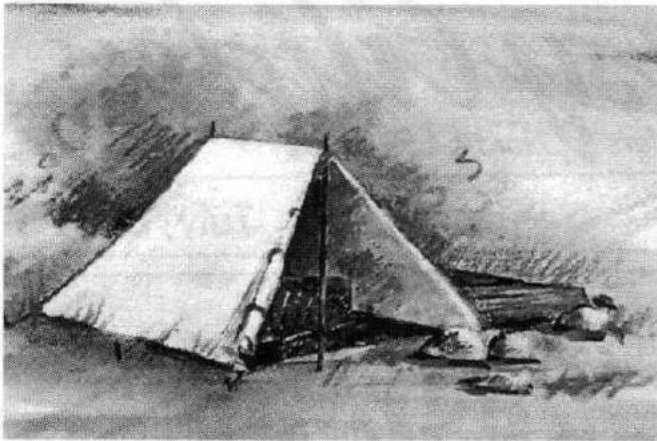
GETTING TO RIVER HOUSE:

- From Harrisburg, take US 22-322 west toward State College.
- **DRIVE PAST** the exits for Linglestown Road (PA 39) and Fishing Creek Valley Road
- **TAKE THE EXIT** marked "Dauphin Boro-Stony Creek"
- Proceed **STRAIGHT** ahead into Dauphin Borough. You will see a small shopping center on your left.

- Turn **LEFT** onto the cross street immediately past the shopping center.
- Turn **RIGHT** where the cross street ends at a retaining wall for the new highway
- Turn **LEFT** at the first available left turn, following the street under the new highway and the railroad. This road ends at a T-junction by the river.
- Turn **LEFT** at the T-junction, and follow the street until it ends (about a quarter mile).
- The street will change from blacktop to gravel, and you will cross Stony Creek on a small concrete bridge and pass by a sign stating, "Private Road/No outlet".
- **You've ARRIVED!**
