COVID-19 Policy for 2021-2022 Ski Season

COVID-19 remains a serious health concern as we approach the upcoming ski season. That concern is heightened when club members gather in confined spaces as we do in the accommodations we secure for our extended trips. Therefore, the club's Executive Board has enacted the following policies to reduce those health concerns.

- 1. All extended trip participants must be fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus by the beginning of the trip, including the vaccine manufacturer's specified post injection waiting time.
- 2. Participants shall present proof of vaccination to the Trip Leader by the trip's "balance due" or "reservation due" date for each trip they participate in. A CDC "COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card" or similar verifiable proof of immunization is required. Reproductions of the record are acceptable.
- 3. Participants must similarly comply with any additional CDC immunization recommendations, such as vaccination boosters.
- 4. Due to privacy concerns the club will not maintain a central record of immunizations.
- 5. So that the club may comply with our lottery rules for high demand trips, proof of immunization or a commitment to become fully vaccinated prior to the trip is required prior to the August 16 lottery.
- 6. Reservations for persons who do not present proof of vaccination by October 31, 2021, will be canceled and their deposits will be returned.



Up-coming Events

September 16, Thursday - Hike Darlington Trail to the AT

Join Dave Powell on a 4-mile hike on the Darlington Trail to the Appalachian Trail and the Cumberland Valley overlook. Depart the trailhead on the peak of the Miller's Gap Road over Blue Mountain at 10:00 AM.

To reach the trailhead:

- Go to Visaggio's Ristorante, 6990 Wertzville Rd, Enola, PA (Corner of Millers Gap Rd)
- Drive north on Millers Gap for 2 miles to the top of the mountain.
- From where the pavement ends go another 50 yards to the parking lot on the left. (Lat: 40.3024, Lon: -77.0640)

Notes:

- Bring water and snacks.
- The first part of the trail is rocky, so wear good sturdy shoes.

After the hike we could meet for lunch at:

- Sophia's (129 Walden Way) for soups & sandwiches,
- Home Slice (111 Walden Way) for pizza & ice cream or
- IDEA (121 Walden Way) for coffee & Pastries.

An outdoor patio is available for all three.

Extended Trip Participation

As of the early deposit date of July 26, 2021, three of the scheduled ski trips for the 2021-2022 ski season were oversubscribed. The three trips were Laurentians, North Conway and Lake Placid. Andrea Hospodar and Nancy Borremans, co-leaders of the North Conway trip, were able to *double* their trip's capacity so that everyone who sent a deposit for that trip can be accommodated. A lottery for the Laurentians and Lake Placid trips was held via Zoom on August 16, 2021. As is often the case, one of the people who lost out in the lottery stepped up to run a concurrent trip for each of these oversubscribed trips, so there are only a couple of people on the waitlist for each of these trips.

Sign-ups for the remaining trips on our schedule are going well. Many of the trips are nearing capacity, but there is space on several of the trips. If you want to go on a trip, check with the trip leader and/or treasurer to see if there is space available.
